The eatery is centered around its hand-pounded chicken tenders, which are made with all-natural and antibiotic free chicken brined in lemon juice, pickle brine and buttermilk, and infused with a proprietary blend of herbs and spices. Additionally, the brand offers a selection of 22 signature sauces, as well as popular sandwiches and salad bowls, and hand-spun desserts. Chicken Guy! is set to open this summer.
